The University began by offering two academic programmes in 1987, viz., Diploma in Management and Diploma in Distance Education, with a total strength of 4,528 students. Presently the University, with total active enrolment of over 4 million students, claims to be the largest university in the world.

Since its commencement IGNOU has striven to build an inclusive society through Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode, and providing quality higher education opportunities to all. Apart from teaching and research, extension and training form the mainstay of its academic activities. It also acts as a national resource centre, and serves to promote and maintain standards of distance education in India.

About IGNOU Regional Centre, Lucknow

Regional Centre, Lucknow was established on 1st December, 1986 with one study centre under its supervision at Jai Narain Degree College, Lucknow. Afterwards, Regional Centre, Lucknow has undergone tremendous growth in terms of learners and study centres. At present, Regional Centre, Lucknow is catering the learners of central UP covering 32 districts with 76 Learner Support Centres. It has been shifted to its new campus in the year 2015.

About Programme Study Centre 27108

Shri Jai Narain PG College has the distinction of having first Learner Support Centre (2701) in the entire North Zone established in the year 1986 by a Memorandum of Understanding between the Ministry of HRD and the Management of the College. IGNOU has further entrusted the College by establishing another Learner Support Centre, viz., Programme Study Centre 27108, in the year 2006 especially dedicated to run two year B.Ed. programme with an annual intake of 100 in-service teachers. Dr. L.B. Bajpai was appointed the first Programme In-charge. He was succeeded by Dr. S.L. Mali and Dr. Renu Srivastava, respectively. Dr. S.C. Pandey was given the responsibility of Assistant Programme In-charge and was succeeded by Dr. Ram Bachan and Dr. Sushma Mishra, respectively.

When the NCTE revised the structure of teacher education programmes, the Programme Study Centre 27108 was the only PSC associated with Lucknow Regional Centre which was allowed to run B.Ed. programme though with a reduced enrolment of 25 in-service teachers for the academic session 2016 and 2017 each. The annual enrolment was raised to 50 the very next year. Presently, the annual intake of enrolment in B.Ed. programme has been increased to 55. In addition to two

year B.Ed. programme, PSC 27108 has been given the responsibility to conduct five new programmes, viz., MAEDU, PGDHE, PGDEMA, PGDET and PGDSED from January 2020.
